# WHAT IS NETLIPSE?

**NETLIPSE** is:

- **Network** for the dissemination of best practices and lessons learnt in the management and organisation of **Large Infrastructure Projects** in **Europe**.

NETLIPSE aims to help project professionals deliver better large-scale infrastructure projects in Europe through four strategic objectives:

- **Network Development** – To maintain and expand a network of public professionals, researchers, and organisations responsible for, or active in, the delivery of large-scale infrastructure projects in Europe.
- **Knowledge Sharing** – To increase the understanding of the factors that influence the performance and success of large-scale infrastructure projects in Europe by providing opportunities for dialogue, collaboration, the exchange of knowledge and experiences, and research.
- **Enhance Competences** – To enhance the skills and competencies of the network members, and to support the development of their leadership and collaborative capacities.
- **Support Client Organisations and Projects** – To provide direct support to client organisations and projects that face specific challenges and/or wish to improve their performance in managing and delivering their projects.

# OUR MAIN ACTIVITIES

## 1. Bi-Annual Network Meeting

- Two-day Network Meetings with 50 – 80 participants from target group organisations.
- Facilitate networking as well as knowledge development and exchange through in-depth discussions.

## 2. IPAT® Assessments

- 6 – 9 IPAT Assessments per year, improving project delivery by providing insights from an experienced assessor team.

## 3. Provide Expertise

- Workshops, webinars or consultations with NETLIPSE experts on specific topics or issues related to the management and delivery of large infrastructure projects.

## 4. Research Initiatives

- With European universities for studies and to promote research results.
- An annual Research Café where researchers share findings and obtain relevant input.



# NETLIPSE NETWORK CHARACTERISTICS

- Started in 2006 as an EU-funded research project. Since 2010 financed through partnerships and sponsorships.
- Unique client network: 'For the public sector, by the public sector'.
- Open to (public sector) participants: clients, project managers, researchers.
- Not for profit.
- Focus on knowledge development and knowledge exchange on managing and organising large infrastructure projects in Europe.
